Tripod Drinker Instructions 201, 301 and 401





How To Fill A Tripod Drinker

- 1. While the tank and basin are empty, push the rubber stopper completely over the hole in the spout.
- 2. Unscrew the cap and fill the tank with water.
- 3. Screw the cap back on. Ensure the cap has a rubber seal inside and is very tight.
- 4. Push the rubber stopper back up the spout, away from the hole.
- 5. Wait for the water to find its level.
- 6. Refill in the same way when the tank is empty, or as needed.

How To Clean A Tripod Drinker

- 1. Unscrew the cap.
- 2. Add approx. 500g of pea gravel or similar to the tank
- 3. Make a solution consisting of 1 litre of water and 10ml of 910018 ETON Appliance Cleaner 1litre or similar (dilution rates may vary- check manufacturers guidelines).
- 4. Pour the solution into the tank
- 5. Repeatedly swirl the pea gravel and water/disinfectant solution around the tank in a circular motion. The pea gravel will provide a scrubbing action (the same principle is used in wine decanters).
- 6. Pour the pea gravel and water/disinfectant solution out of the tank
- 7. Refill the tank with clean, fresh water only and swirl round the tank 3 times
- 8. Refill with water up to the desired level and replace the cap with rubber seal

How To Clean A Tripod Feeder

Thorough Cleaning

- 1. Unscrew the cap.
- 2. Wipe out any excess food remnants with a clean cloth
- 3. Add approx. 500g of pea gravel or similar to the tank
- 4. Make a solution consisting of 1 litre of water and 10ml of 910018 ETON Appliance Cleaner 1litre or similar (dilution rates may vary-check manufacturers guidelines).
- 5. Pour the solution into the tank
- 6. Repeatedly swirl the pea gravel and water/disinfectant solution around the tank in a circular motion. The pea gravel will provide a scrubbing action (the same principle is used in wine decanters).
- 7. Pour the pea gravel and water/disinfectant solution out of the tank
- 8. Refill the tank with clean, fresh water only and swirl round the tank 3 times
- 9. Dry the tank thoroughly with a clean, dry cloth
- 10. Replace the cap

Light Cleaning

- 1. Unscrew the cap
- 2. Wipe out any excess food remnants with a clean cloth
- 3. Make a solution consisting of 1 litre of water and 10ml of 910018 ETON Appliance Cleaner 1litre or similar (dilution rates may vary-check manufacturers guidelines).
- 4. Submerge a clean cloth into the water and disinfectant solution and wipe around the inside of the tank
- 5. Dry the tank thoroughly with a clean, dry cloth
- 6. Replace the cap
